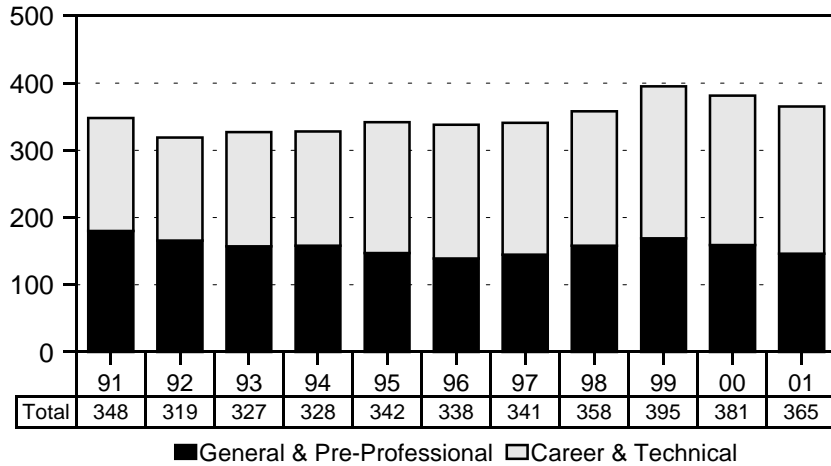

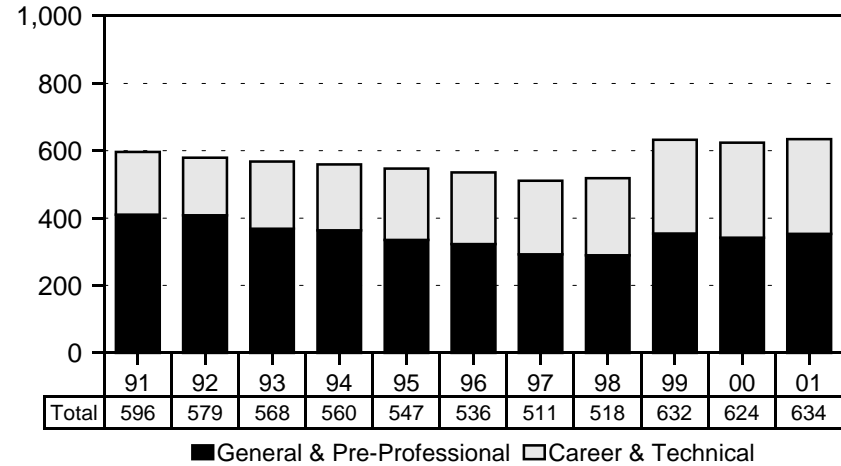

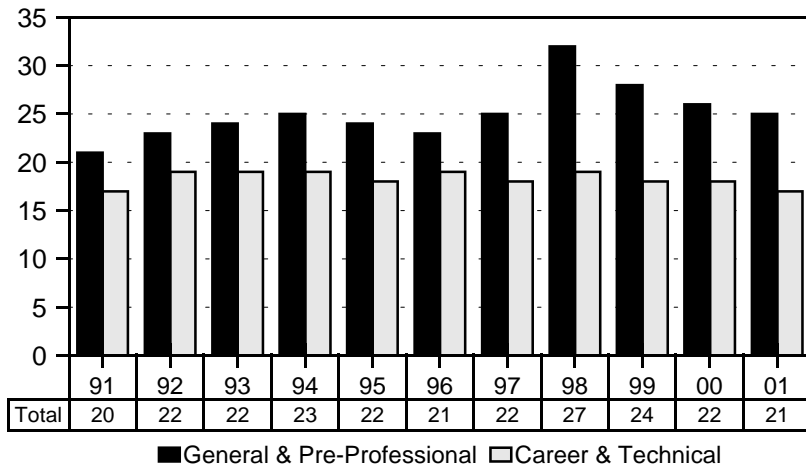
Number of Courses



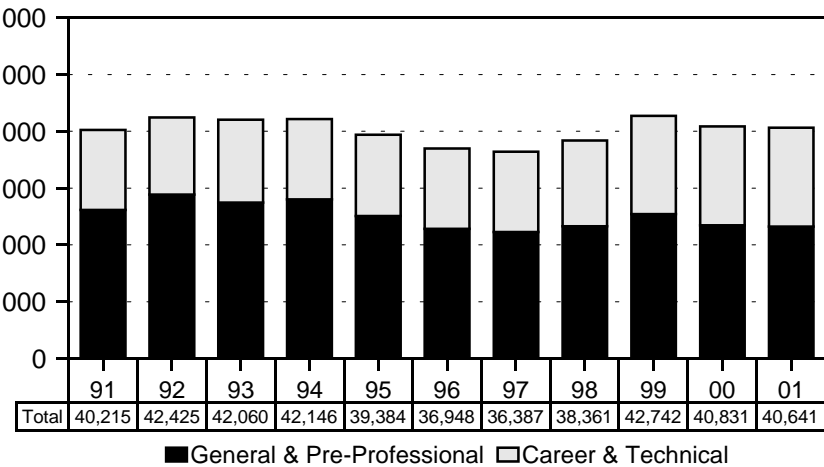
Number of Classes
