From Public and Private High Schools, Fall 1997

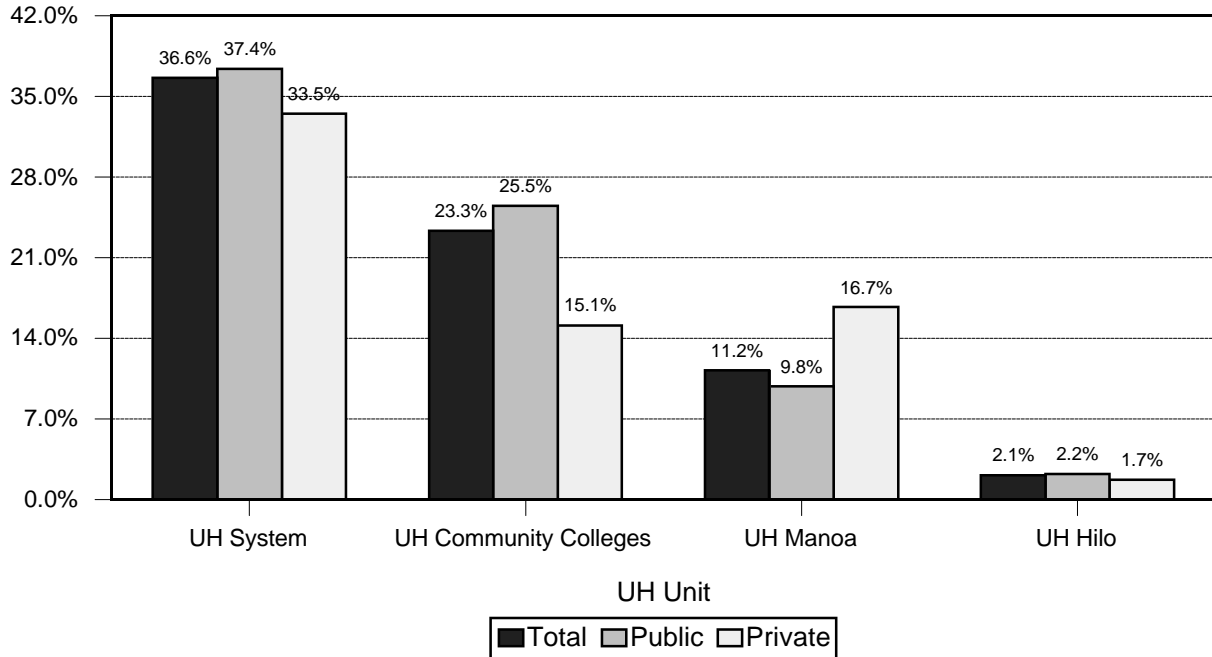
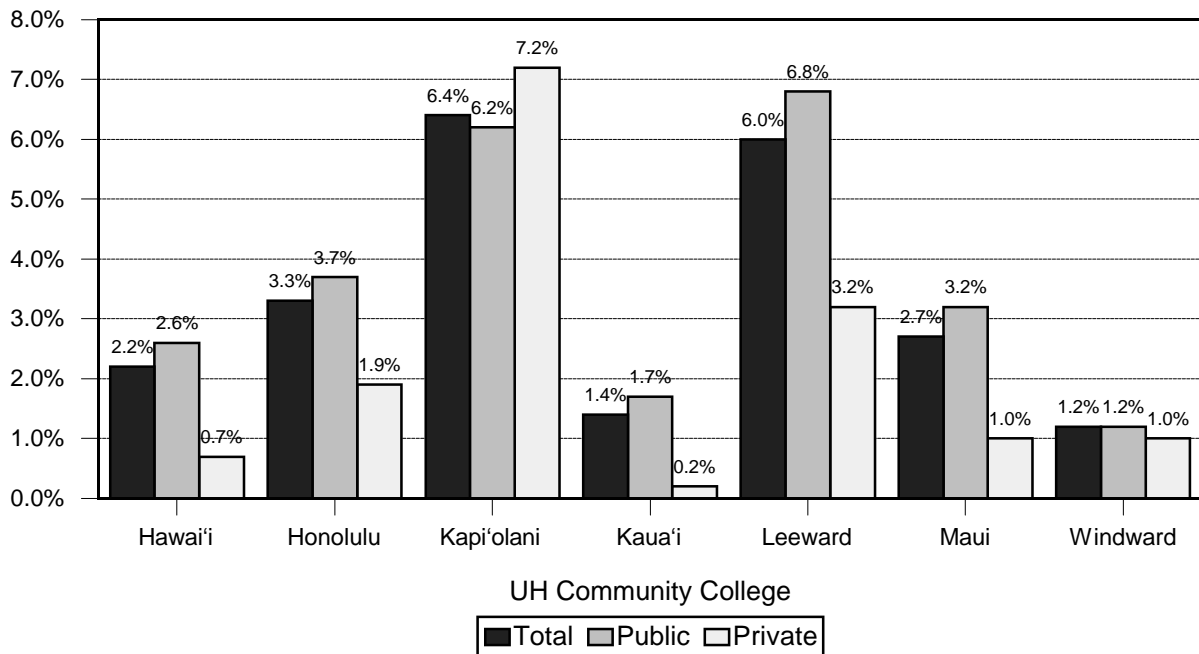

Going Rates By UH Community College, Historical

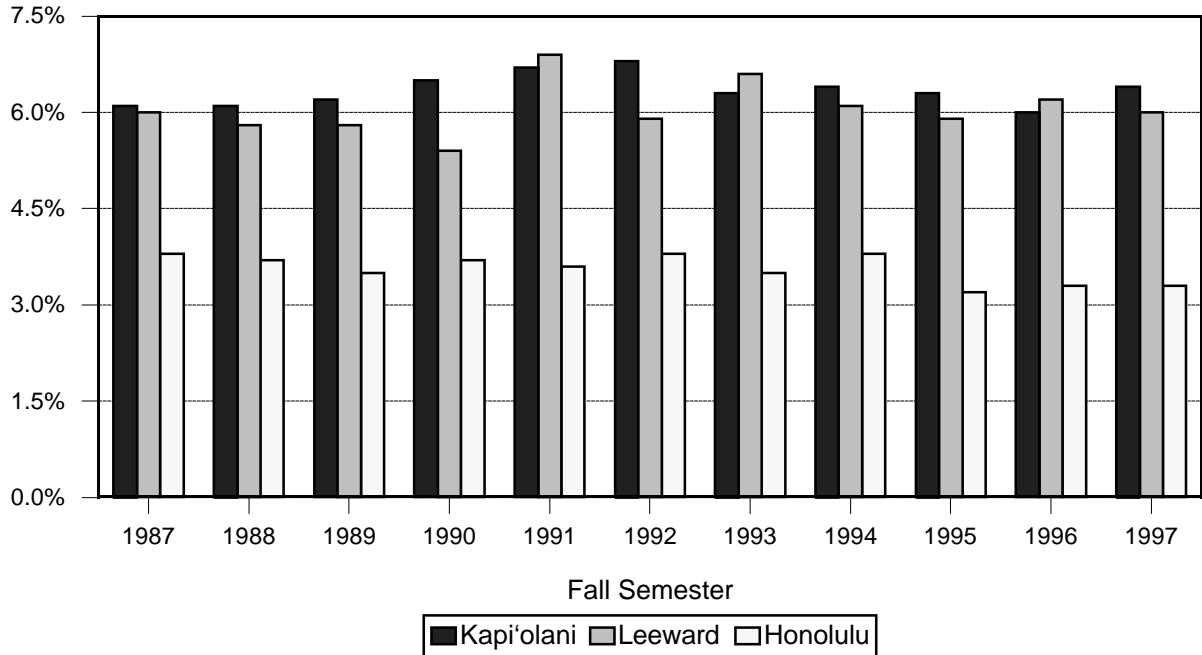

Going Rates By UH Community College, Historical

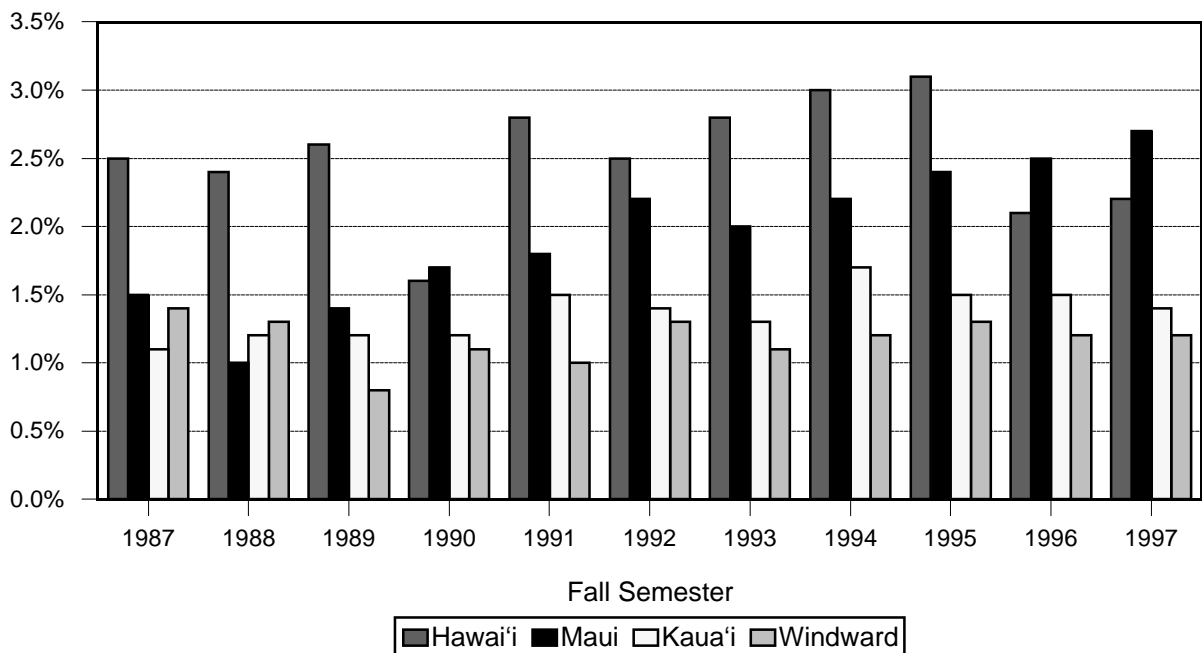
