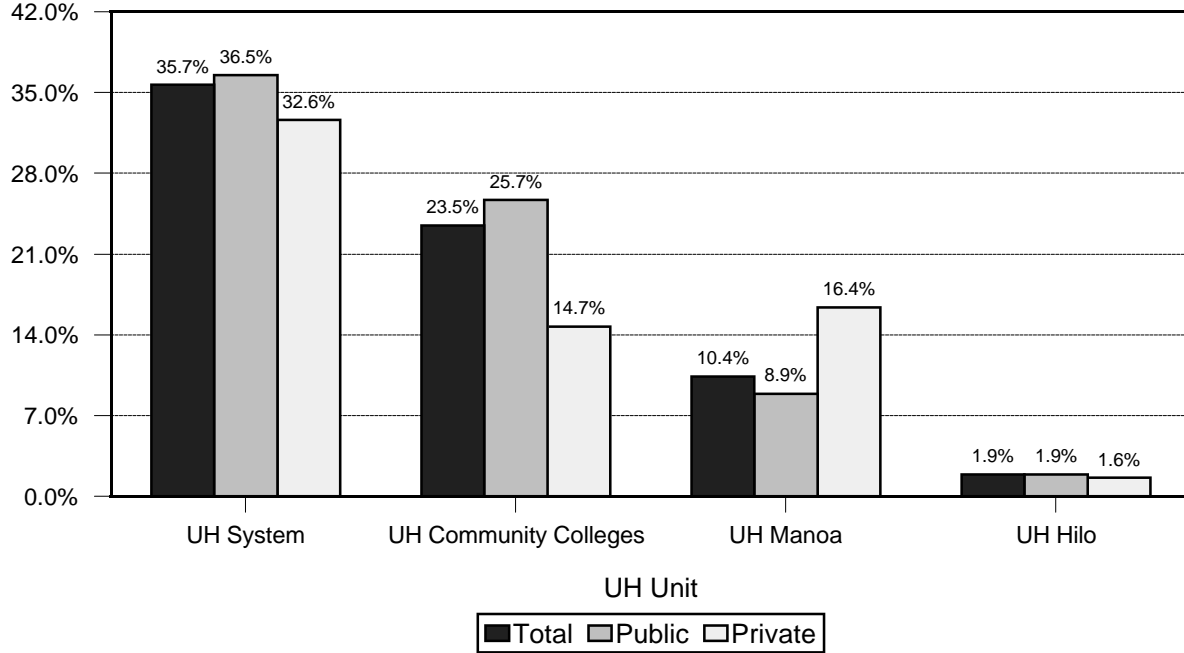

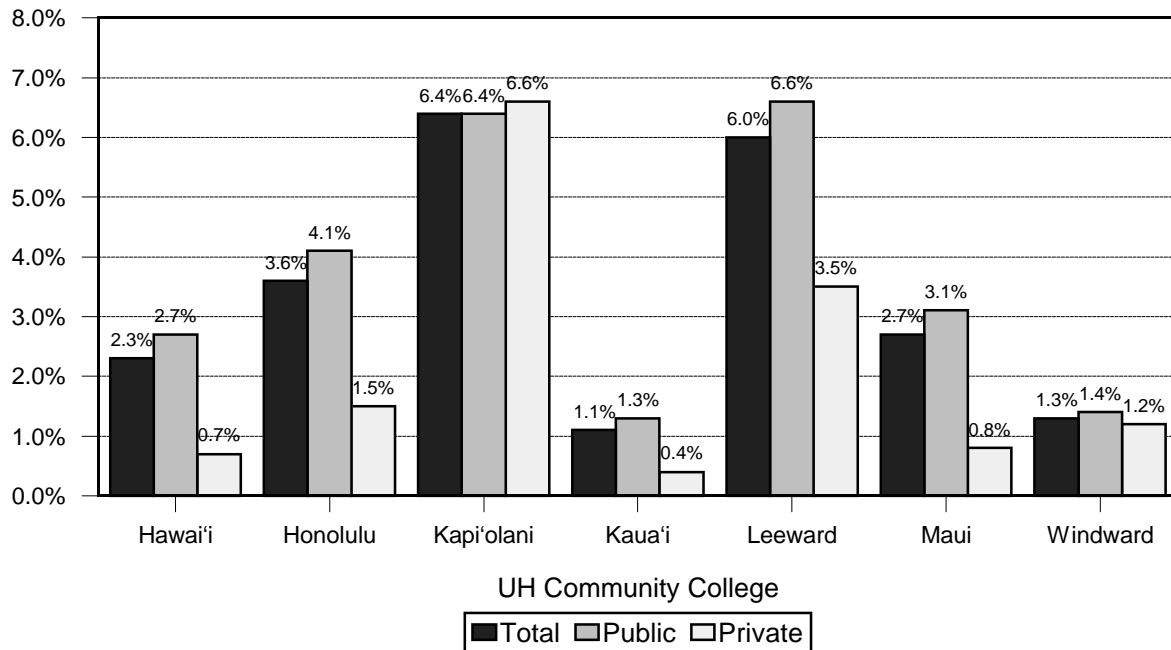

Going Rates By UH Unit, Historical

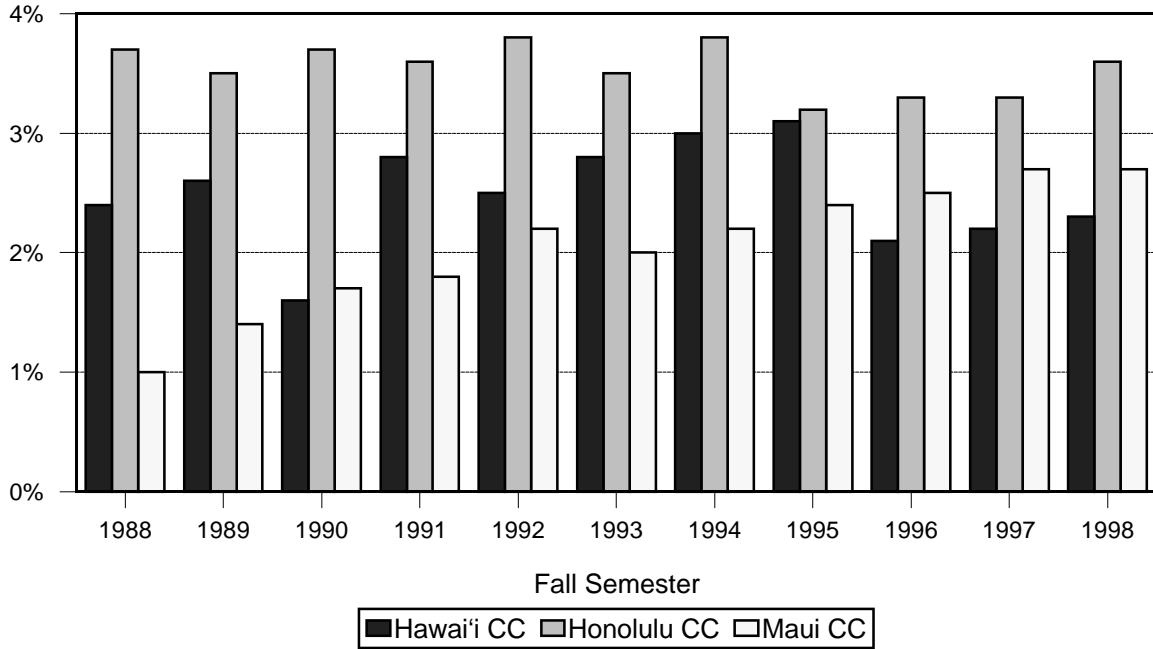

Going Rates By UH Unit, Historical

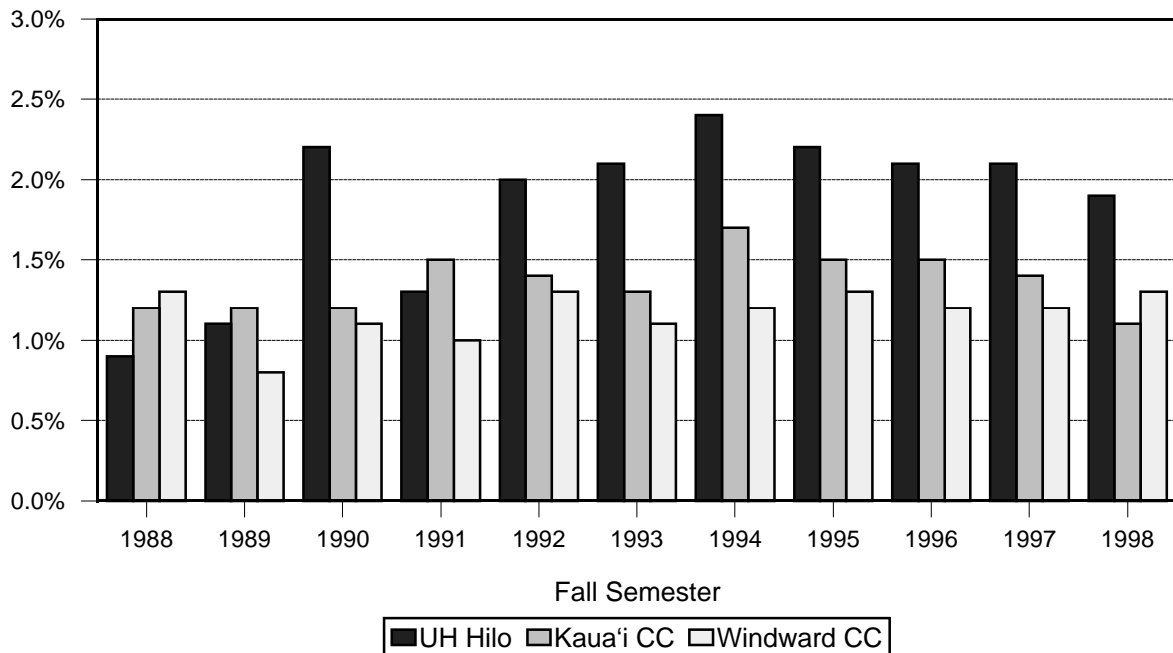
