From Public and Private High Schools, Fall 1999

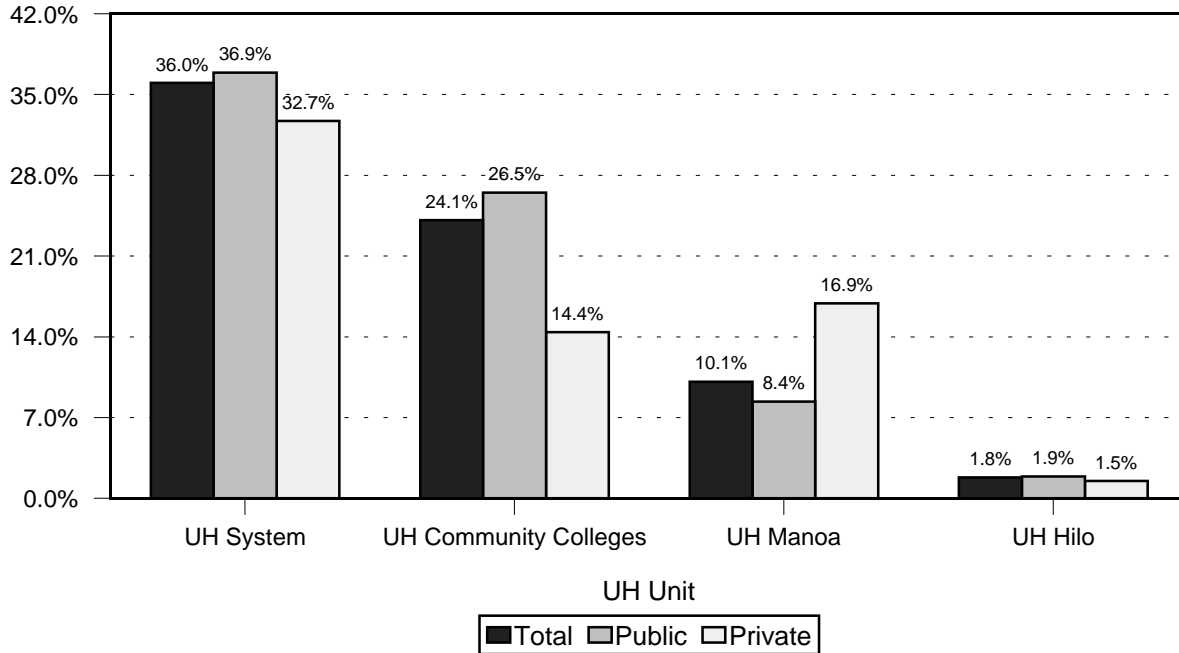
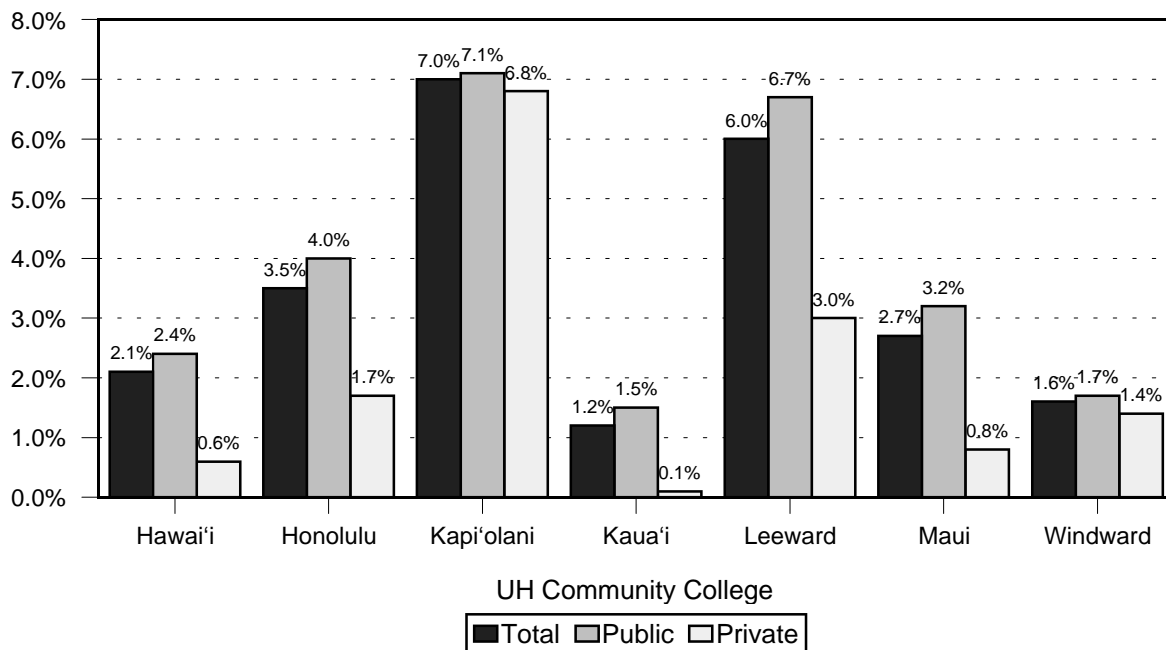

Going Rates By UH Unit, Historical

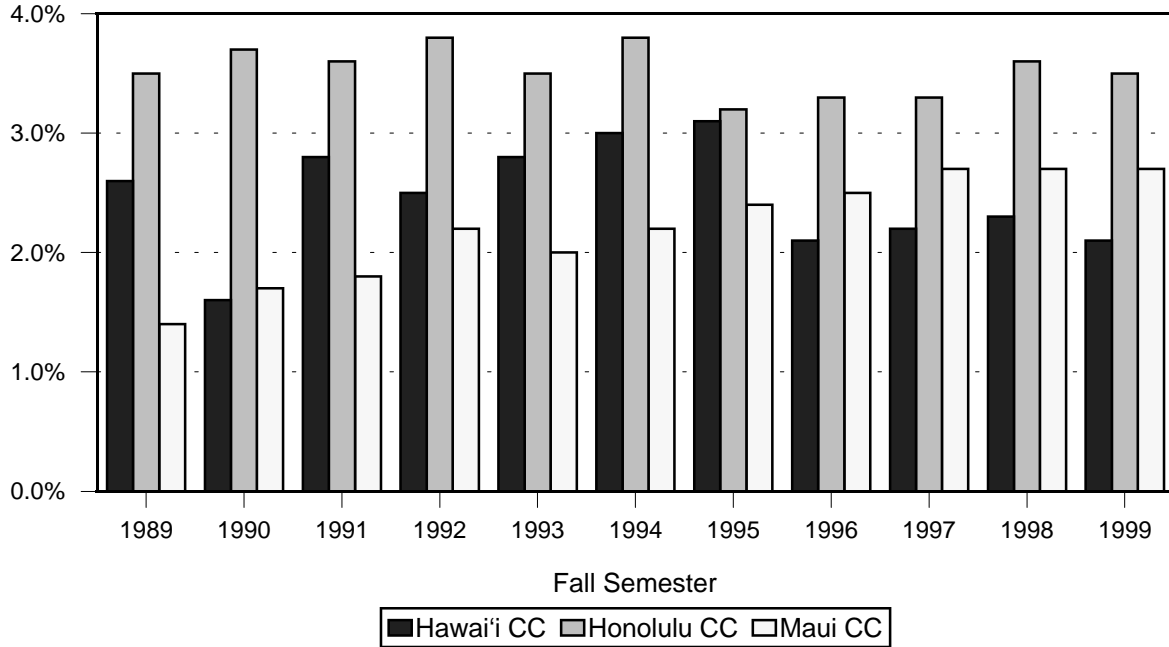

Going Rates By UH Unit, Historical

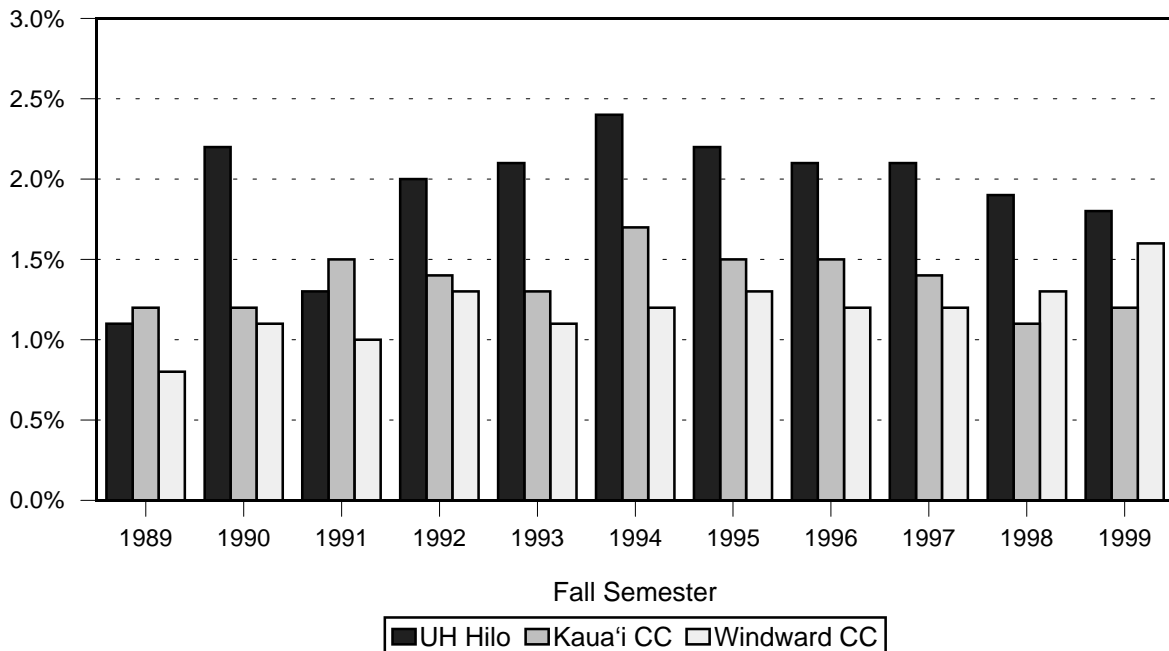
