Currently, the PACE program is running at/near maximum capacity. The faculty involved cannot keep up with the demand from the teachers and schools asking that HCC run PACE workshops for the ECE teachers who need to work towards their certification. The additional resources requested here represent an investment in growth. While the expenditure of these funds would not generate an immediate payback, over the space of the next two years or so, additional revenues will be achieved through the offering of additional workshops. While we have not had time to research and develop specific numbers, this investment will likely generate a positive return in terms of a fiscal contribution to the College.

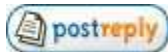

I might also say, in regards to items 47, 49, & 51, UH Manoa ITS presently has no plans for similar "HD" driven upgrades (though consultations with Oceanic Time Warner are underway). ♦Like the studio, it would be prudent to make any new installations and repair replacements HD cable. ♦For example, all TV's and monitors required replacement are replaced with 1080i HD equipment. ♦And the Campus Television Network certain is in need of constant repair and requested expansion.
