

Campus Clubs Point System

***Registered Independent Student Organizations (RISO) will be hereby referred to as Clubs.*

Club Documentation	10%

Send Club Senator to all Senate meetings	20%

Club Point System Breakdown

Club Documentation:

Updated and current documentation of club activity will ensure that positive communication exists between clubs and ASUH-HCC. Each club will be responsible to submit club registration forms, club notification of meeting, club meeting agendas, and club meeting minutes with member attendance. Agendas and Minutes needs to be submitted two weeks after the official meeting date. If a club completes all that is stated above, the club will receive the entire 10% for club documentation.

Fundraising:

Each club will need to do at least one fundraiser per semester in order to earn the full 10% for fundraising. Proper documentation must be submitted no later than two weeks after actual fundraising event for clubs to receive full points. *(See ASUH-HCC Forms S-18 and S-19)*

Host Campus Events:

Hosting events on campus is a good way to promote the club and recruit new members. Also, hosting events is a good way to develop

student leadership skills by learning how to construct an event. Each Club will need to host three campus events per semester that all students may participate in to obtain the entire 10%. Proper documentation must be submitted no later than two weeks after hosting event for clubs to receive full points. *(See ASUH-HCC Forms S-32)*

Community Service:

Giving back to the community is essential. 5% will be rewarded if the club finds a way to service their community through a project of their choice. The other 5% will be rewarded if the club participates in a college community event. Ex. Great Aloha Run, Kalihi Christmas Parade etc. A total of 10% can be obtained for Community Service.

Representation at Campus Club Committee Meetings:

It is important that clubs are informed of ongoing Senate and other club activities. Each club will elect their own club senator. Club senators should attend all campus club committee meetings. If a club senator is unable to attend the meeting, any other club member may attend in his or her absence. No excuses will be accepted. If full attendance is achieved, the club will receive a full 10%.

Send Club Senator to all Senate Meetings:

Each club will be required to send a Club Senator to all Senate meetings. An alternative club representative will be accepted in a club senator absence. In the event that an alternative club member is unable to attend the Senate meetings, a Senator may proxy his or her vote twice per semester and still receives the full 15%.

Volunteer at Senate Events and Activities:

Participation in Senate activities allows clubs to interact with other clubs and the entire student body. Clubs will be rewarded points for volunteering for an event hosted by campus. All events will be documented with club participants. In order to receive full points for an event a minimum of two members must participate.

In the event of a tie, all projects undertaken by the club will be assessed. The Executive Board of ASUH-HCC will decide who the winner is based on the information given by the clubs.
